The planned new construction will help create a sustainable and functional church facility for future generations.

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

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

Construction Process of the Mother Teresa Church: FOUNDATION BASE





Construction Process of the Mother Teresa Church: Section 2-2



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The Church of Saint Mother Teresa in Dugajeva

Offer for the supply of materials and execution of work on the church according to the project.

Based on the solution for the church project according to the architectural design and the choice of construction method with suitably high-quality materials as described below, the price for the supply of building materials and the execution of work on the church up to its completion has also been provided.

Descriptions of material quantities and the method of execution of the work.

1	Excavation of the ground according to the project's adaptation to the existing terrain for the construction of the church, in accordance with the project dimensions for leveling the entire project area.		
2	Filling with 0/60 aggregate over the entire building area according to the project dimensions, with the required thickness for leveling the terrain and compacting to the proper height.		
3	Spread of 4mm gravel aggregate over the entire building area with an average thickness of 10cm.		
4	Reinforced concrete in the dimensions of the house with a thickness of 5 cm in the first part and 3 cm in the second part, covering the entire area of the object.		
5	The waterproofing with "Kondor" bitumen paper, 5mm thick, covering the entire area of the foundation slab and extending 15 cm deep for the reversal, as well as in the vertical area of the formwork boards. After the removal of the boards, the waterproofing will continue up to the bitumen blocks, which will be of the highest quality, produced by SUPREMA from Germany.		
6	The foundation – the massive ground slab or counter slab of the building with a thickness of 40 cm made of reinforced concrete C-25/30, reinforced with \emptyset 12mm rebar at 20 cm intervals in two zones and in two directions.		

	Within the slab, there will also be braces or rings, each with 10 pieces of Ø 12mm rebar and Ø 8mm stirrups every 20-25 cm, according to the structural solution, using concrete of class C-25/30.	
7	The braces or rings for the specified object will be reinforced with 10 pieces of Ø 12mm rebar and diagonal bars Ø 8mm every 20-25 cm for all levels of the object.	
8	The building columns will have dimensions of 40x25 cm within the thickness of the exterior walls, while for the interior walls, a width of 25 cm and a length of 340 cm are planned. The columns in the attic area, which will have a two-story attic with brickwork, will have dimensions of 35x35 cm and will be reinforced with 10 pieces of Ø 12mm rebar and diagonal bars Ø 8mm every 20-25 cm.	
9	The exterior walls of the basement will have a thickness of 25 cm with solid grid blocks, while the interior walls will have a thickness of 20 cm with the same blocks.	
10	The floor slab of the nave is designed as a solid plate with a thickness of 20 cm, reinforced with Ø 12mm rebar in the lower section at intervals of 18-20 cm in two directions, and in the upper section with Ø 12mm rebar at intervals of 18-20 cm.	
11	The exterior walls of the first floor will have a thickness of 25 cm with solid grid blocks, while the interior walls will have a thickness of 20 cm with the same blocks.	

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The total cost of all work until completion is €274,340				
The price for the construction up to the roof ridge (superstructure) is € 162,500				
13	The entire construction of the roof ridge will also include the installation of PVC membranes as roofing, followed by gutters in the lower parts of the structure, downspouts at specific locations, and vertical gutters at 2 points of the roof ridge construction.			
12	The construction of the roof ridge will consist of rafters with dimensions of 20x12 cm in an area with a height of 4 m, with an 18 mm thick roof deck and 10 cm thick stone wool insulation beneath the roof deck. It will also include Bramac diffusion foil and roofing tiles from Bramac or Tondach.
